RU Express

RU Express is a service provided through Rutgers University Dining Services. When you add money to your RU Express account, it is instantly credited to your ID card. WIFI

To use RUWireless just connect to the network called "RUWireless", open a browser, type in a website such as **www.google.com** or **www.rutgers.edu** and you should be redirected to the RUWireless login page. You will need your NetID and password to login.

Buses

You can access the bus schedule online at **rudots.rutgers.edu**. For specific instructions for taking the bus to orientation, please speak with your Resident Assistant.

If you have a "smart-phone" you can go to **www.nextbus.com**. When asked to allow the website to find your location, select "accept". This will give you up to the minute information about which buses and bus stops are near you and the time of the next bus.

Food

Campus dining halls re-open with a limited schedule the evening of August 25th. Normal dining hall operations resume September 2nd.
